CityCare & North View Primary School Launch New Recipe book to Help Needy Elderly

A group of five students from North View Primary School (NVPS) has published the first-ever collection of home cooked recipes contributed by residents of an elderly nursing home.

Recipes of Love is a culmination of a community project done by five Primary Six students, after principal Ng Yeow Ling engaged CityCare to tailor a community-based training programme for his students.



Mr Masagos Zulkifli, Senior Parliamentary Secretary for Education and Member of Parliament for Tampines GRC, launched the book on 26 October at All Saints Home, where the students had spent their after-school hours taking notes on the recipes through befriending and interacting sessions.

Each of the 14 recipes is representative of the fond memories shared by their contributors and their family, and guests at the launch were treated to one of the dishes in the collection, *Kueh Pie Tee*.

A social innovation project supported by the Citigroup Foundation, the young project team hopes to raise funds for the elderly through sale of the book, and convey the message that "elderly are valuable and they can still contribute to society".
